

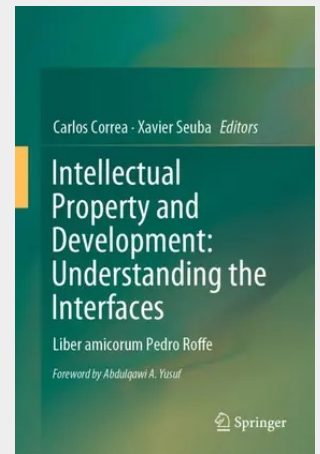
Intellectual Property and Development: Understanding the Interfaces
