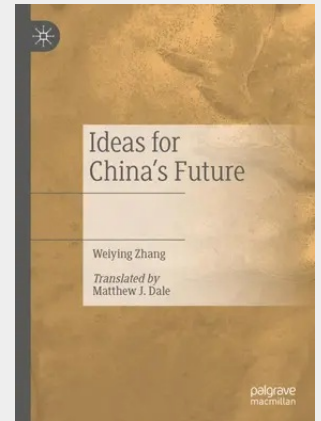


Ideas for China's Future
