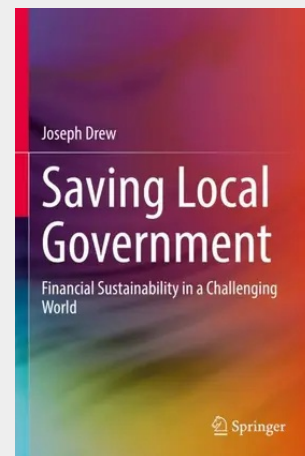
Saving Local Government
