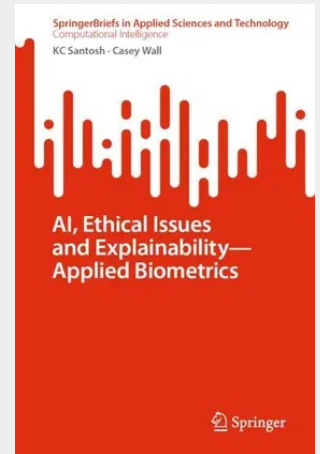


AI, Ethical Issues and Explainability-Applied Biometrics
