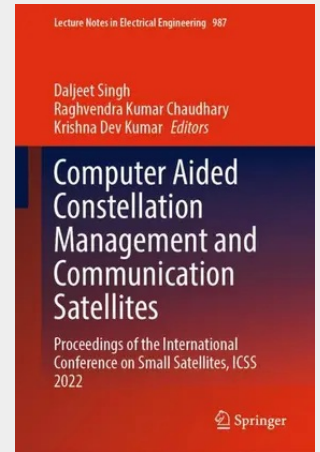


Computer Aided Constellation Management and Communication Satellites
