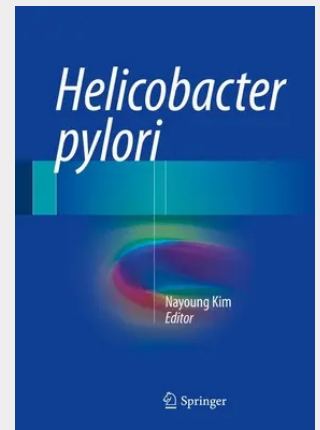


Helicobacter pylori
