

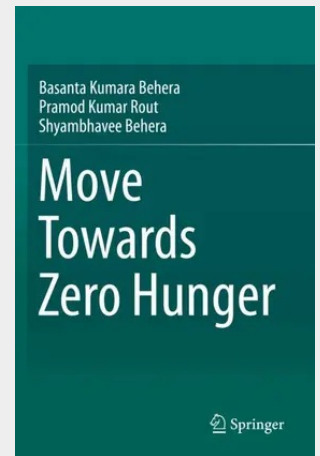
Move Towards Zero Hunger
