

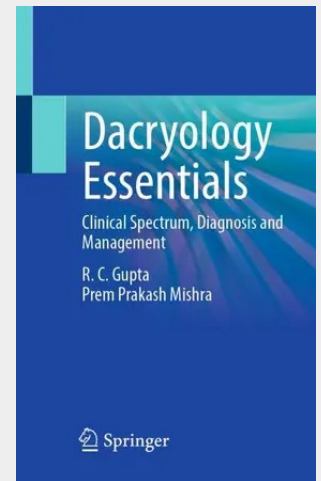
Dacryology Essentials
