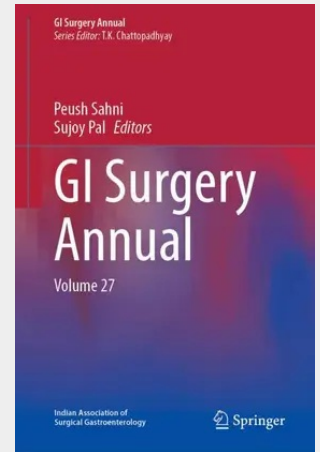


GI Surgery Annual
