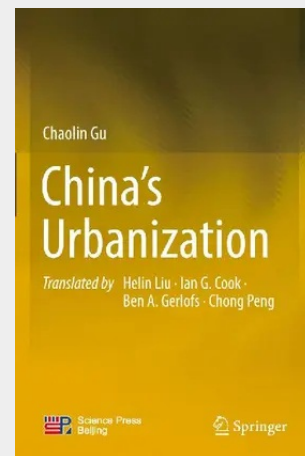


China's Urbanization
