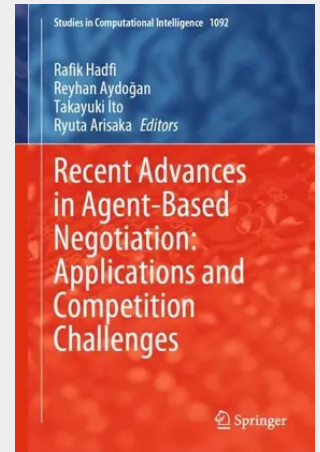


Recent Advances in Agent-Based Negotiation: Applications and Competition Challenges
