After reading this book, you will be able to build web applications with Blazor in C#11 and .NET Core 9.0.

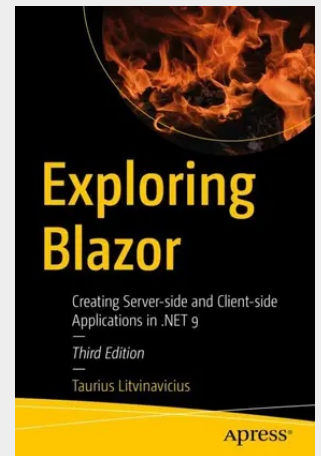
