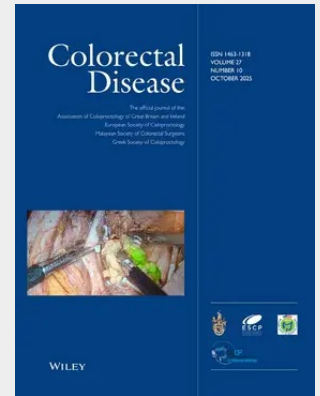


Colorectal Disease

Colorectal Disease publishes original research & reviews regarding the epidemiology & aetiology, diagnosis, classification, management, prognosis and long-term sequelae of lower gastrointestinal tract diseases. It also welcomes submissions relating to aspects of healthcare processes that directly impact patients with lower gastrointestinal diseases such as: • health service provision / organisation • health economics • the conduct of high-quality research • the training & education of healthcare professionals Manuscripts relating to sociocultural and political issues as well as wider workforce matters are outside of the scope of Colorectal Disease.



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
