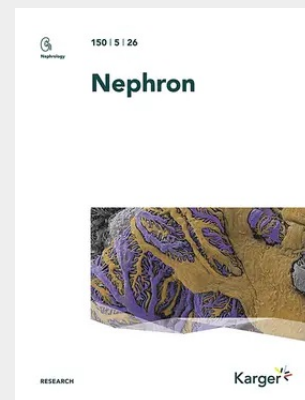


Nephron
