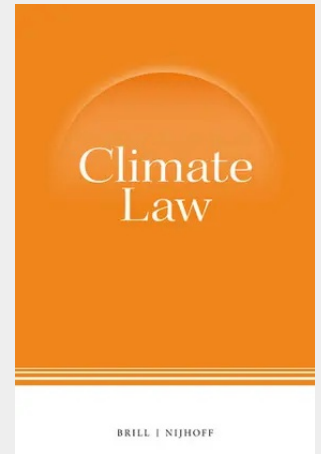


Climate Law
