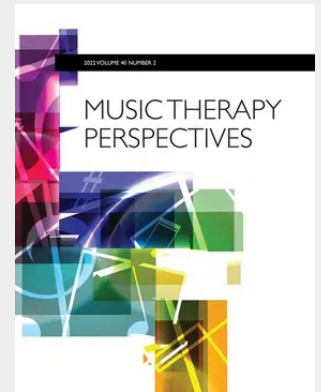


Music Therapy Perspectives
