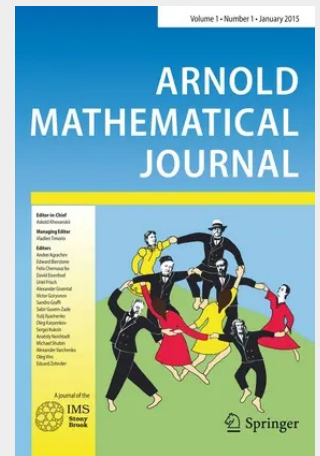


Arnold Mathematical Journal

This journal intends to present mathematics so that it would be understandable and interesting to mathematicians independently on their narrow research fields. We invite articles exercising all formal and informal approaches to "unhide" the process of mathematical discovery. The name of the journal is not only a dedication to the memory of Vladimir Igorevich Arnold (1937-2010), one of the most influential mathematicians of the twentieth century, but also a declaration that the journal hopes to maintain and promote the style which makes the best mathematical works by Arnold so enjoyable and which Arnold implemented in the journals where he was an editor-in-chief. The ArMJ is run jointly by the Institute for Mathematical Sciences (IMS) at Stony Brook, USA, and The Association for Mathematical Research. The journal is Diamond Open Access. It is indexed in MathSciNet and ZentralBlatt.



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
