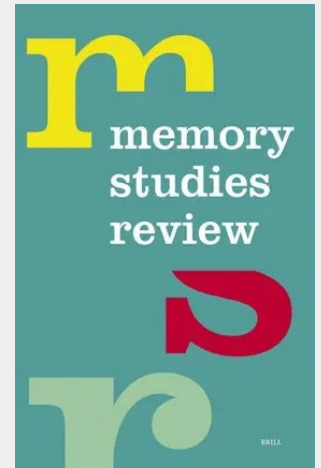


## Memory Studies Review

We likewise encourage scholarship with innovative understandings of agency in order to enable a reconsideration of the interrelation of subjectivity and materiality, and the human and non-human.
