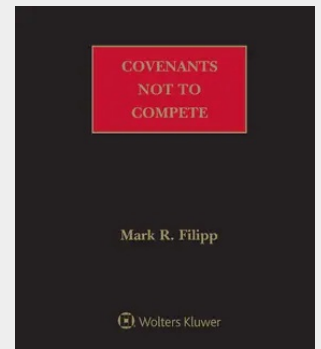


Covenants Not to Compete
